Promotion/Graduation Policy - 6th, 7th & 8th Grade Students

All students in the 6th, 7th & 8th grades at Sacred Heart School must earn thirty-six (36) points in the seven basic subject areas each year to be eligible for promotion and/or graduation.

1. The seven basic subject areas will include Religion, Reading, Language Arts, Spelling, Mathematics, History, and Science.
2. Points will be allotted in the following manner: A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1.
3. Students should attain at least twelve (12) points per trimester, but must attain thirty-six (36) points per year to pass to the next grade or graduate.
4. Failure to achieve thirty-six points will result in retention for 6th and 7th grade students for one year only. *8th grade students who fail to achieve thirty-six points will not graduate.

*Failure to graduate will exclude said student from participation in all 8th grade school related graduation activities and ceremonies. No diploma will be received and the student will not be promoted, as noted on the report card.

Note: Final decision shall rest with the Principal.

5. Passing the U.S. Constitution test is a requirement for graduation.

It is acknowledged that the above policy will be used for promotion/graduation for Sacred Heart School for the current school year.
